

FAQ – City of the Lakes Holiday Walk

**How will I find my tree when I go to decorate?**

Each tree will have an 11" x 7" Sign with the name of the sponsor on it. Enjoy a nice stroll through the many trees and find your name. Trees are located in Rotary Park, Stewart Park and in the green area in front of Fit Focus.

**How big are the trees?**

Each tree will be 5 to 6 feet tall. You might need a step stool to get to the top

**Can I add extra lights to the tree?**

No, please do not add extra lights to your tree, but you can add a lit tree topper. The set-up is specific for two strings of lights per tree. Add more lights could cause the trees to go out.

**Can I add my business or organization logo to the sign?**

Yes, you can send your logo to [connect@celebratelaconia.org](mailto:connect@celebratelaconia.org) and we will add your logo to the sign. We suggest sending a scalable vector graphic image to ensure that your logo is clearly displayed. (.eps, .png, or .pdf are best formats)

**Do I have to decorate the tree? I would like to sponsor one but I do not want to decorate it.**

No, but your name or business will be on the tree as the sponsor and we would love to see your holiday spirit. Celebrate Laconia is completing the hardest part by setting up and lighting the tree. All you have to do is the fun part and put on the decorations. Donating to the cause is another option for contributing if you do not want to decorate a tree.
